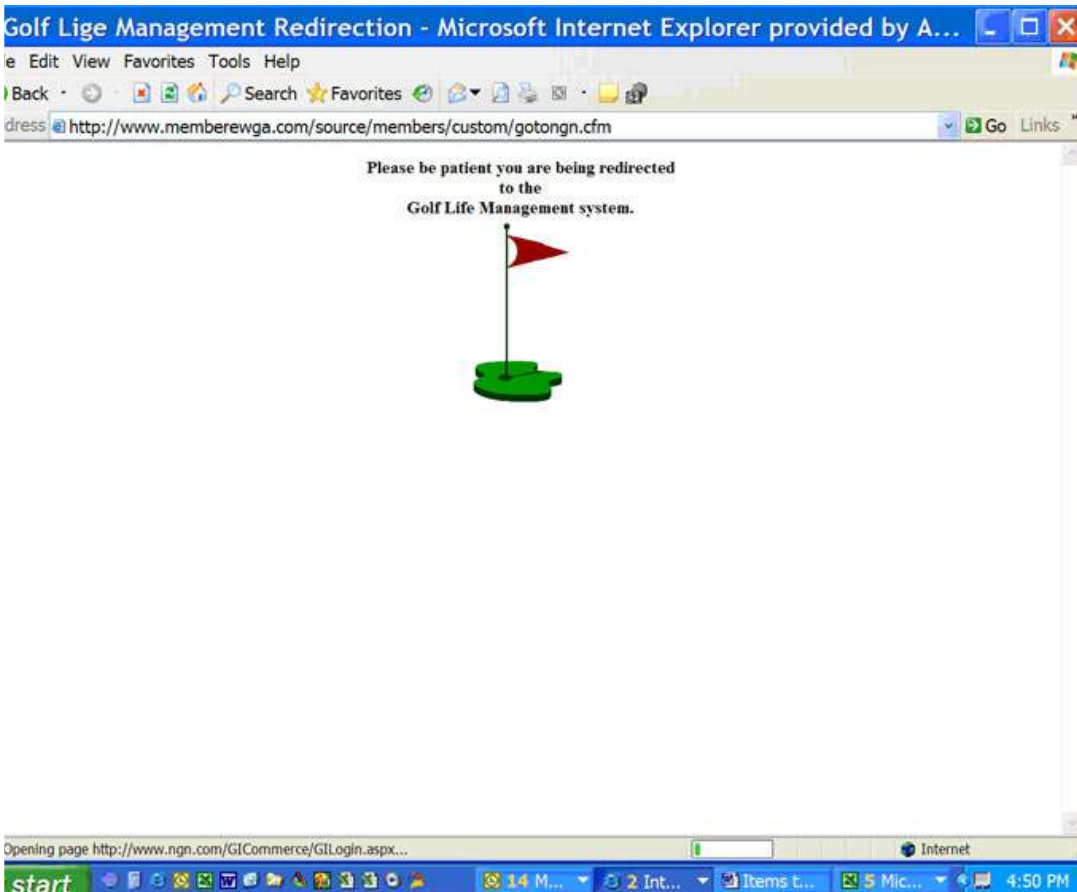




Posting a score on the EWGA Golf Life Management System

1. To access the EWGA Golf Life Management System, go to the EWGA website www.EWGA.cor and login to the Members Only area.
2. The link to the Golf Life Management System will be with the left side links at the bottom and says: Golf Life Management System.
3. When you click on the Golf Life Management System link you will be transferred to your personal Home Page on the EWGA Golf Life Management System. You will see the screen below while you are being transferred.

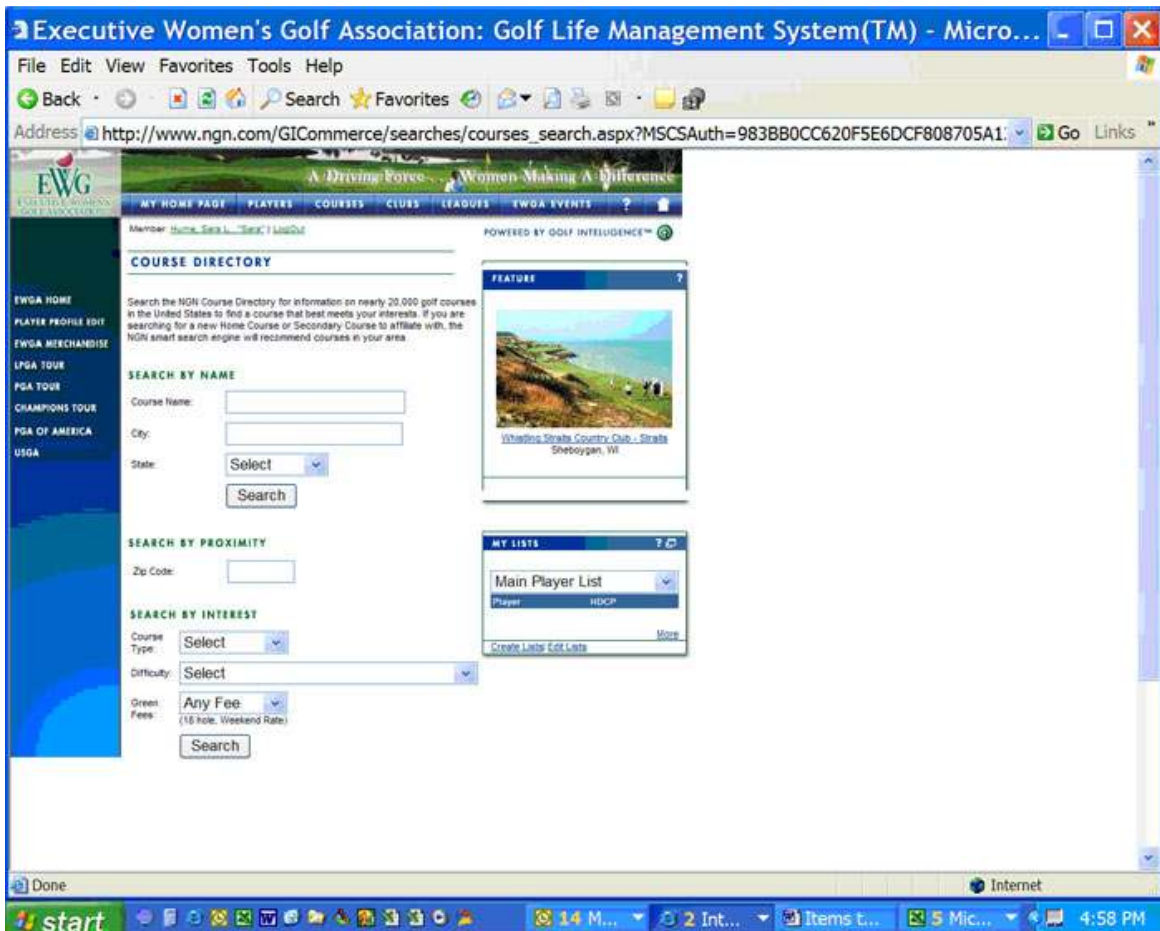


4. Once you are in the EWGA Golf Life Management System you will see your personal Home Page.

5. The system has over 17,000 courses in its database. Before starting to post scores, it is advisable to create a personal list of courses frequently played. This will assure that the courses you frequently play are in the current database, that the tees you play are listed and that the slope and rating for those tees is correct. To do this, click Courses in the top menu bar and you will see the following screen which will allow you to search for your favorite courses. (NOTE: One of your Chapter's Host Clubs has already been added to your personal list.)



6. Once your course is displayed, click on the course name and check the data. Then add them to your personal list of courses by clicking on ADD TO MY LIST.
7. If one of your favorite courses is missing or information on the course needs updating, please send an email to courseupdate@ewga.com and let us know. We will see that the Course database is updated. You will still be able to post if the course is missing or the information is incorrect. Please see POST A SCORE (8c) below.

PLEASE NOTE: The EWGA Golf Life Management System Course Database is regularly updated by Golf Intelligence with course ratings and slopes from the data available in the USGA Course Rating database* and through regular contact with courses around the country to obtain the most accurate and recent course ratings for all tees at a course.

Sometimes a course may have had a slope and rating update and the scorecards used at the course may not yet reflect those more recent updates. We encourage you to post your scores to the courses by name and use the slope and rating in the Course Database unless the course is missing completely or unless you have checked with the course to confirm that the slope and rating for the tees you played needs to



be updated in the EWGA Course Database. If you are sure the slope and rating needs to be updated in the database, send an email to courseupdate@ewga.com.

8. POST A SCORE: In this system you can post your total score or your hole by hole score to the golf course where you played. This is done from your personal Home Page.
 - a. To post a total score select **POST TOTAL SCORE** and enter the following:
 - The date
 - Select a course from your personal course list or search the course directory. (See 8c below if your course is not found or the data for the course is incorrect.)
 - Select the tees from which you played
 - Check to make sure the slope and rating matches the scorecard used. If there are any changes send an email to courseupdate@ewga.com.
 - Enter your total score adjusted for equitable stroke control.
 - b. To post a hole-by-hole score **POST HOLE-BY-HOLE SCORE** and enter the following:
 - The date
 - Select a course from your personal course list or search the course directory
 - Choose which statistics to track such as total putts, fairways hit, etc.
 - Select Go To Scorecard and enter the hole-by-hole information.

NOTE: To post hole by hole scores, a correct scorecard for your favorite course needs to be in the course database. Help us keep the database up to date by letting us know any updates needed for any courses that you play.



- c. To post a score when the course is not found in the current database, select **Course not found – enter manually** from the Course Name dropdown box. Enter the information from POST TOTAL SCORE above with the addition of the Course Rating and Slope. (NOTE: you can not enter a hole-by-hole score for a course not found)

PLEASE NOTE

1. The EWGA Golf Life Management System uses popups, please configure your web browser to allow popups from this site.
2. If your internet access is through a dial up modem rather than a high speed connection there could be delays while screens are loading. We are working on improving the access speed for all areas of the system.
3. If you had your handicap with your EWGA Chapter and we were able to obtain that data, your scoring records have been imported although your tournament scores may be missing. Contact your state golf association to obtain your tournament scoring records if you do not have them or contact golf_life@ewga.com
4. If you do not see any entries in your Scoring Record and you have maintained a handicap in the past year, you will need to obtain a printout of your scoring history from your state golf association or from the club that managed your handicap and enter the past scoring records into the system.
